**Field Hall Foundation Announces
\$255,800 in New Grants**
Over \$860,000 Has Been Awarded In 2022 to
Address the Needs of Older Adults

CORTLANDT MANOR, NY, October 20, 2022 – Field Hall Foundation has awarded \$255,800 in new grants through its Fall 2022 grant cycle. The funding will be used to improve the lives of vulnerable seniors and their caregivers in Dutchess, Putnam, and Westchester Counties.

Grant recipients include:

Mount Vernon Neighborhood Health Center

\$50,000 – To provide mobile mental healthcare to homebound seniors living in Greenburgh

Open Door Family Medical Center

\$50,000 – To provide intensive case management and navigation to un- and under-insured, high-risk seniors in Putnam and Westchester Counties

HOPE Community Services

\$45,000 – To provide mobile case management to low-income seniors in New Rochelle

United Way of Westchester and Putnam

\$30,000 – To provide transportation for seniors in Putnam and Westchester Counties

DOROT

\$15,000 – To provide services through their Westchester Response Team Program that will both help older adults continue to live independently and alleviate social isolation

Dutchess Outreach

\$15,000 – To provide healthy and fresh foods to low-income, food insecure seniors through their food pantry and community meal program

Hospice of Westchester

\$15,000 – To provide hospice services to Westchester County seniors

Second Chance Foods

\$15,000 – To provide healthy home-delivered meals and groceries to food insecure seniors living in Putnam County

Furniture Sharehouse

\$10,800 – To provide furniture to low-income adults in need in Westchester County

Solace House

\$10,000 – To provide free mental health therapy for older adults in Westchester County

The Foundation has awarded more than \$860,000 in grants in 2022. It is currently accepting Letters of Inquiry for its Spring 2023 grant cycle; the deadline for submission is January 31, 2023.
