Field Hall Foundation Announces Fall Grants to Support Seniors and their Caregivers

CORTLANDT MANOR, NY, October 29, 2025 – Field Hall Foundation has announced \$259,220 in grant awards as part of its Fall 2025 grant cycle. The funding will enhance programs that help seniors remain independent, combat food insecurity, and ensure access to essential services including transportation, respite care, home repairs, case management, and emergency financial aid.
